

Council Meeting Summary

29 April 2019

The Council held its regular meeting on 29 April 2019. The following discussions and actions took place.

- Our MYP Coordinator, Joseph Szalay. Gave a presentation to the Council concerning proposed changes to our language B offerings at ISL in 2019-20. Following discussion, it was decided to offer French and German in grades 4-12 and discontinue Latvian B in grades 4-12 and Russian B in grades 4-8. Russian B will continue to be offered in grades 9-10 and continue through the DP provided there is continuing student interest by the students currently taking the course. Latvian Studies will continue in the elementary school and we will integrate Latvian history, culture and geography into our Middle Years Program.
- The Council received and discussed staff engagement survey results and next steps to improve specific areas identified.
- Mr. Larson informed the Council he will retire following the completion of his contract in July 2020.
- The Council reviewed the March management report.
- The Council approved the 2019-20 annual budget and an increase in prekindergarten tuition fees to Euro 6,000 per year noting that the current fee structure does not support the costs of the program. All other grade level tuition is increased by 2% as per school practice.
- The Council approved a revamped organizational structure to include subject team leaders to improve teacher input and communication.
- The Council approved a revised Grievance and Whistleblower policies.
- The Council approved the summer work plan.

The next Council meeting is scheduled for May 20, 2019.
